


Major Needs

Guiding Principles of the Strategic Alliance

The Strategic Alliance:

- 1. Is a partnership
- 2. It is NOT a merger, NOT an acquisition, and NOT a sale
- 3. Will not impact MHD's lease with MGH nor its authority over the hospital (no change in the District's reserved powers)
- 4. Will result in an investment of funds into the Marin community
- 5. Will improve the depth and breadth of healthcare services offered in Marin
- 6. Will have in place pre-negotiated termination provisions



Key Terms of the Strategic Alliance

MGH

- Designates UCSF Health as its primary academic and teaching partner
- Allows UCSF Health the right of first opportunity to provide tertiary/quaternary medical services in collaboration with MGH and our physicians
- Allows UCSF Health to nominate 2 MGH Board Members requiring MHD Board approval
- Adheres to UCSF Health guidelines for quality and co-branding
- Installs UCSF Health EPIC inpatient Electronic Medical Record (EMR) at UCSF Health's incremental cost

UCSF Health

- Commits funds for inpatient and outpatient projects that are jointly approved by MGH and UCSF Health
- Integrates MGH affiliated physicians as part of UCSF Health while retaining the current physician and management structure
- Provides outpatient EPIC EMR in MGH affiliated physician offices
- Leads collaborative efforts for quality improvement and care coordination
